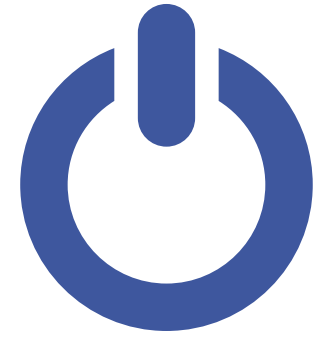




Digital Skills Support in Bolton
